Jane Doe's Legacy Gift to The Food Depot*

- *Gift Type:* Bequest in Will and Beneficiary Designation

- *Specific Use: \$500,000 Bequest:* Establish the "Jane Doe Food Security Fund" to provide meals to individuals living in New Mexico experiencing food insecurity.
- *Life Insurance Policy:* Name The Food Depot as the beneficiary of a \$500,000 life insurance policy, designated for the purchase of fresh produce and healthy food options.
- *Implementation:*
 - Memorandum of Understanding (MOU): An agreement with The Food Depot outlining the use of the funds for enhanced food security.
 - Recognition: The Food Depot will induct Jane Doe into the Legacy Society and include on the Legacy Society Mural.

By following these steps, you can create a meaningful and lasting legacy gift that addresses food insecurity and supports the vital work of The Food Depot in your community.
